PRIVACY STATEMENT

This policy applies only to the practices of the specific entity or website that is mentioned here, ie DgFee, which is a part of Dgdiary.

This Privacy statement is incorporated into and subject to the DgFee terms of use. If you do not agree to the terms of this Privacy Statement, you reserve the right to not provide us with any information and do not use / subscribe to the site /app / service.

ACCEPTANCE OF THESE TERMS

This Privacy Policy is incorporated into and subject to DgFee Terms of use. By using DgFee and providing personally identifiable information of either yourself or your clients, you consent to the collection and use of such personally and identifiable information as set forth in this Privacy Policy.

INFORMATION COLLECTED

You agree to provide accurate information as required by us for your usage of the system. DgFee shall not collect any information that is not needed for the usage of the system. At the time of system set up, you may be required to provide to DgFee certain information which includes names, addresses, phone numbers, and email addresses for yourself and your clients (students or their parents/ guardians), collectively referred as "User Profile content".

Upon registration on DgFee, you may be assigned one or more login IDs and passwords that will enable you to access DgFee. You shall take responsible precautions to protect against theft, loss or fraudulent use of such usernames and passwords, and you are solely responsible for any losses arising from another party's use of such IDs and passwords, either with or without your knowledge.

The Students's online Privacy and Protection Act ("COPPA") requires that online service providers obtain parental consent or provide notice before they knowingly collect personally identifiable information online from students who under 13. We do not knowingly collect or solicit personally identifiable information from a child under 13 or otherwise, except in the following circumstances.

1. We may collect a child's name (first, middle and/or last name), date of birth, email address and /or telephone number, and the child's parent's telephone number and/or email address to provide notifications to parents for the purpose of providing services through DgFee for which you have signed up for.
2. We may collect personal information through the services from a child under 13 or otherwise, where that student's school, district, and/or teacher has parental consent for them to use the services to disclose personal information to us, for the use and benefit of providing services through DgFee. We are not responsible to verify that the school / teacher has obtained the consent.

3. If you are a teacher, administrator, member of accounting or finance team or the signing authority at the school, you represent and warrant that you have permission and authorization from your school and /or govt authorities (if applicable) to use the services, and for purpose of COPPA compliance, you represent and warrant that you are agreeing to these terms on behalf of your school and/or govt authorities.
4. You may be required to provide valid school credentials and a valid school email address to verify your identity to access and use certain features of the services.

If we come to know that any personal information has been collected from a student under 13 or otherwise, other than pursuant to the above, or if we learn that a student under 13 or otherwise, has provided personal information beyond what we request from her or him, we will delete that information as quickly as possible. If you believe that a student under 13 or otherwise, may have provided us personal information in violation of this paragraph, please contact us at info@dgdiary.com

We receive and store any information you knowingly enter on or provide to us for the services of DgFee, whether via computer, mobile phone, other wireless device, or that you provide us in any other way. This information may include Personal Information such as your name, phone number, email address, photograph, and, in certain circumstances, your school affiliation, which is used to provide notifications to you via the Services of DgFee from a teacher, department, school, and/or district (“alerts”), and any other information necessary for us to provide DgFee services.

USE OF INFORMATION

User profile consent shall be retained by us only as custodian of such information and data. That such information and data shall only be used by for specific services signed up by you and not by us for other purposes unless requested by the school/school representative in order to facilitate interaction between you and your clients (students / parents / guardians).

Any user may email us at info@Dgdiary.com , if such user no longer wishes to receive communications from the services. Under such circumstances, we will notify you if we receive it from your clients for you to decide the next course of action.

DATA INTERGRITY

We do not share, sell or rent your or your clients’ personally identifiable information to third parties. We will not share or distribute any user information with third parties except as provided below.

1. When required to do so by law or regulation, or in response to a request from a law enforcement agency or governmental agency or other authority or to establish/exercise our legal rights/ defend against legal claims.

2. In order to investigate, prevent, or take action regarding illegal activities, suspected fraud, situations involving potential threats to physical safety of any person, violations of our terms of use, or as otherwise required by law.
3. If we are required by or merged with other company, we will notify you about such an acquisition or merger and you being subjected to any different privacy policy.
4. Or any other unforeseen circumstances that are not mentioned above.

Notwithstanding the above, we may employ other companies and people to perform tasks on our behalf and may need to share your information with them (and for them to use that information) in order to provide aspects of our service to you. Some examples of services for which we may use agents include sending emails or SMS texts, analyzing data, and providing user services. These agents may use personal information we share with them, for example, to assist us, to provide their services to you and/or us, and to measure and improve the performance of the services. We may work with third-party websites to enhance your online experience, to send messages or letting you to add “apps” to your account. We have no control over the policies and practices of third-party websites or services as to privacy or anything else, so if you choose to allow the automatic transmissions discussed above, please review all third-party websites’ or services policies before disclosing any Personal information or other content on the website or on any third-party website or services.

DATA PROTECTION

We have adopted reasonable industry standard practices to ensure that there are adequate safeguards and techniques to protect the data of the user against any unauthorized or unlawful disclosure. We will not store, copy, disclose or use the data of the users except as necessary for the performance of our services and obligations under this agreement.

We employ physical, electronic and procedural safeguards to protect the information we receive from you from unauthorized disclosure. We limit access to personal information on our systems to our employees and employees of affiliate organizations, who we believe need to come into contact with that information to provide services to you or in order to do their jobs.

You should not share your password or sign-in details with anyone. In addition, if you suspect unauthorized access to your information, it is your responsibility to contact us immediately.

We will never ask you to divulge your passwords over phone calls, or in written or electronic communications except when we communicate your login credentials during set up of the school system for you. It is your responsibility to change the password after we have assigned it to you for your security.

We will retain the information provided by you for as long as your account is active or as needed to provide services.
